- Chickens – no more than six chickens will be permitted on any property within the City – Minimum number of chickens is two for their social wellbeing.
- Husbandry animals – Minimum number of two for their social wellbeing.
- Applicant must continue to comply with all City, State and Federal Statutes or the permit can be revoked by the City Administrator.
- Permit expires December 31 of current year. Annual renewal fee is \$10.00.
