The City Council of the City of David City, Nebraska, met in open public session at 7:00 p.m. to hold a public hearing for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to the proposed budget for fiscal year 2021-2022. The meeting was held in the meeting room of the City Office located at 557 N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, David City, Nebraska. The Public had been advised of the meeting by publication of notice in The Banner Press on August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021, and an affidavit of the publisher is on file in the office of the City Clerk. The Mayor and members of the City Council acknowledged advance notice of the meeting by signing the Agenda which is a part of these minutes. The advance notice to the Public, Mayor, and Council members conveyed the availability of the agenda, which was kept continuously current in the office of the City Clerk and was available for public inspection on the City's website. No new items were added to the agenda during the twenty-four hours immediately prior to the opening of the Council meeting.

Present for the meeting were: Mayor Alan Zavodny, Council members Tom Kobus, Pat Meysenburg, John Vandenberg, Bruce Meysenburg, Kevin Woita and Jessica Miller, City Attorney Joanna Uden, City Administrator Clayton Keller and City Clerk Tami Comte.

Also present for the meeting were: Sheriff Tom Dion and Jerry Kosch.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Alan Zavodny informed the public of the "Open Meetings Act" posted on the east wall of the meeting room and asked those present to please silence their cell phones. He also reminded the public that if they speak tonight in front of the Council that they must state their name and address for the record.

Mayor Zavodny declared the public hearing open at 7:01 p.m.

City Administrator Clayton Keller said, "According to new state law, LB 148, I have to address a few items, a comparison between the current budget 2020-2021 and the prior budget 2019-2020. The 2019 tax levy was .5 and the tax request was \$743,398.49. The disbursements for 2019 were \$20,012,218 and for 2020 the tax levy was .5 and the tax request was \$805,818.14 and the disbursements we anticipate being \$10,026,248. I believe that satisfies the state statute."

The presentation required by LB 148 was completed.

Mayor Zavodny stated that he would like to address paving "O" Street and how to pay for it as well as address the park pay and how to recruit and retain park employees.

Mayor Zavodny declared the public hearing closed at 7:08 p.m.

Council member Pat Meysenburg made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Jessica Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried.
