

CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

July 26, 2022

The City Council of the City of David City, Nebraska, met in open public session in the meeting room of the City Office, 490 "E" Street, David City, Nebraska. The Public had been advised of the special meeting by publication of notice in The Banner Press on July 21st, and an affidavit of the publisher is on file in the office of the City Clerk. The Mayor and members of the City Council acknowledged advance notice of the meeting by signing the Agenda which is a part of these minutes. The advance notice to the Public, Mayor, and Council members conveyed the availability of the agenda, which was kept continuously current in the office of the City Clerk and was available for public inspection during regular office hours. No new items were added to the agenda during the twenty-four hours immediately prior to the opening of the Council meeting.

All of the budgets were discussed, and some changes were made by the department heads, Council members and Interim City Administrator/City Clerk Tami Comte.
