The City Council of the City of David City, Nebraska, met in open public session at 7:00 p.m. to hold a public hearing for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to the proposed budget for fiscal year 2022-2023. The meeting was held in the meeting room of the City Office located at 490 "E" Street, David City, Nebraska. The Public had been advised of the meeting by publication of notice in The Banner Press on September 22, 2022, and an affidavit of the publisher is on file in the office of the City Clerk. The Mayor and members of the City Council acknowledged advance notice of the meeting by signing the Agenda which is a part of these minutes. The advance notice to the Public, Mayor, and Council members conveyed the availability of the agenda, which was kept continuously current in the office of the City Clerk and was available for public inspection on the City's website. No new items were added to the agenda during the twenty-four hours immediately prior to the opening of the Council meeting.

The tax levy for 2022-2023 is .50 and the tax request is \$919,966.25 and the disbursements we anticipate being \$22,260,434. This fulfills the provisions of LB 148."

The presentation required by LB 148 was completed.

Mayor Zavodny asked the members of the public to come forward and speak regarding the budget for fiscal year 2022-2023.

Several members of the public spoke regarding the proposed budget and expenditures.

Mayor Zavodny declared the public hearing closed at 7:52 p.m.
