ORDINANCE NO. 1515

AN ORDINANCE TO DETACH THAT CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DAVID CITY, NEBRASKA; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF; AND TO AUTHORIZE PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

WHEREAS, section 18-3316(1) of the Nebraska Revised Statutes allows the Mayor and City Council of the City of David City, Nebraska, a municipal corporation and city of the second class ("<u>City</u>"), to detach property from the City's corporate limits upon a property owner's request; and

WHEREAS, Mark and Willow Holoubek, husband and wife (collectively "<u>Owner</u>"), own that certain real property currently within City's corporate limits known as Tax Parcel Number 120008438 (the "<u>Property</u>"); and

WHEREAS, Owner formally requested City to detach from City's corporate limits that portion of the Property described in the survey in **<u>EXHIBIT A</u>**, attached hereto and incorporated herein; and
